



## **Rules and Regulations 2020 – v1.0**

To ensure the safety and comfort of our members, we have added to or revised these rules and regulations. It's the member's responsibility to adhere to the CDC guidelines and these rules and regulations – and to ensure those in the member's care do too.

### **The clubhouse is closed**

- The ice machine is turned off. Please supply your own ice
- The bathrooms are to be entered from the outside doors. **Only 1 person/household permitted in the bathroom at a time**
- The bathroom lines will be marked for social distancing. Please accompany your child to the restroom
- There will be hand sanitizer available at the entrance and inside the restrooms. There will also be sanitizing supplies in the restrooms
- The water fountain and the outdoor shower are both closed

### **All tables, grills, benches, courts and playground equipment are closed and should not be touched or entered onto. This includes:**

- Tables in the picnic area and in the beach area
- Benches on the island, by diving boards and all benches throughout the grounds
- Swing sets in the picnic area and beach area, the slides and jungle gym
- Horseshoe pits and basketball and volleyball courts

### **Beach umbrellas will be set up at the start of the day and taken down at the end of the day by CLIA staff**

- The umbrellas will be set up to help support social distancing
- Please do not touch or move an umbrella

### **The beach and island area:**

- Social distancing rules apply
- Members are allowed to sit on the sand/beach
- No umbrellas on the beach
- There will be an 'adults-only' seating section created near the clubhouse. Please respect the signs
- CLIA strongly discourages inviting guests to the lake at this time. The CDC recommends limiting close contact with others outside your household in outdoor spaces. Social distancing rules apply to all guests of members
- An entrance and exit lane to the sidewalk will be created. Please follow the signs and avoid blocking this lane
- Cones will be set near the shoreline to create space for bathers and are being used as social distancing markers for bathers. Please sit in the beach area behind the cones



## Water entrance/exit

- To swim, the water is to be entered and exited at the beach shallow end only
- An entrance and exit lane to the sidewalk will be created. Please follow the signs and avoid blocking this lane
- Social distancing rules apply in the water too
- To use a float, please enter the water along the side of the clubhouse near the snack stand

## The diving boards, swim lanes, slides and docks are closed

- The ladders around the diving boards and swim lanes are closed as well

## Lifeguards

- Lifeguards will be on duty starting Saturday of Memorial Weekend from 10am-6pm and every weekend until school ends

## Carry in/Carry out rules are in effect

- Refuse and recycling collection will not be available. Please carry out your trash

## Snack stand will be open Memorial Weekend and weekends until school is out with a limited menu of prepackaged items

- The line will be marked for social distancing. Please ensure adults and children are adhering to a 6' distance while waiting in line

## Social distancing

- While at the lake, it's easy to forget that we're in the middle of a pandemic. Remember CDC guidelines are to be followed.
  - Keep a minimum of 6 feet away from other members
  - Masks are not required but are encouraged to make everyone feel safe and comfortable

## Children under 14 must be accompanied by a responsible party aged 14 or older
